

# Town of Chesterfield Board of Selectmen

## MINUTES March 1, 2007

### Call to Order

Chairman Jon McKeon called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM. Others in attendance were Board members Wanda McNamara, Dan Cotter and Administrator Rick Carrier.

### Appointments

➤ 6:15 Bart Bevis

1. Bevis reminded the Board of the E911 listing that requires their participation and sign off. The Board will schedule a time to meet with Bevis.
2. Bevis advised the Board that mud season will be coming soon and he will be posting weight limits on some roads "per the order of the Select Board".
3. McKeon stated that Tyler from the Conservation Commission had advised that he feels there is more salt on North Shore Rd this year and his well is contaminated. Bevis advised there is no more than last year. Nothing has changed in the amounts or treatment methods.
4. Bevis asked about the meeting minutes that noted the Stanclift driveway. McKeon stated that Larue and Cooper had been in to see the Board and expressed their concern with the beaver dam on Route 63 and if flooding occurred as it had done years ago that the Stanclift driveway may have problems again. McKeon advised there were 2 large boulders that are on corner and are no longer there. Larue and Cooper think these would help stabilize corner. Bevis stated that if boulders were retrievable his department moved them back where they would fit. They have completed the project.
5. McKeon asked if Bevis had any concerns regarding the Welcome Farm roads. Bevis advised his only concern was with the cul-de-sac making it a one way.

➤ 6:30 Jeff Morse and Peter Boemig – Cersosimo

The Board requested documentation of the 2 " base course and 1" wear course that were put on Meadow View Rd and Locust Ln. Morse advised that he believes that Lane Construction did the work. Wally Musgrove had supervised the job for Cersosimo. The Board advised Lane must have invoices to show what was laid and or daily reports of the work. Morse advised they would do their best to get the information.

Bevis asked about the drainage easements. Morse advised there are deeded easements for the Town of Chesterfield. Carrier stated he has the deeds.

Bentley was present in his capacity as Moderator for Town Meeting. The warrant articles were reviewed.
